YOU DON'T KNOW WHAT'S BENEATH THE SURFACE

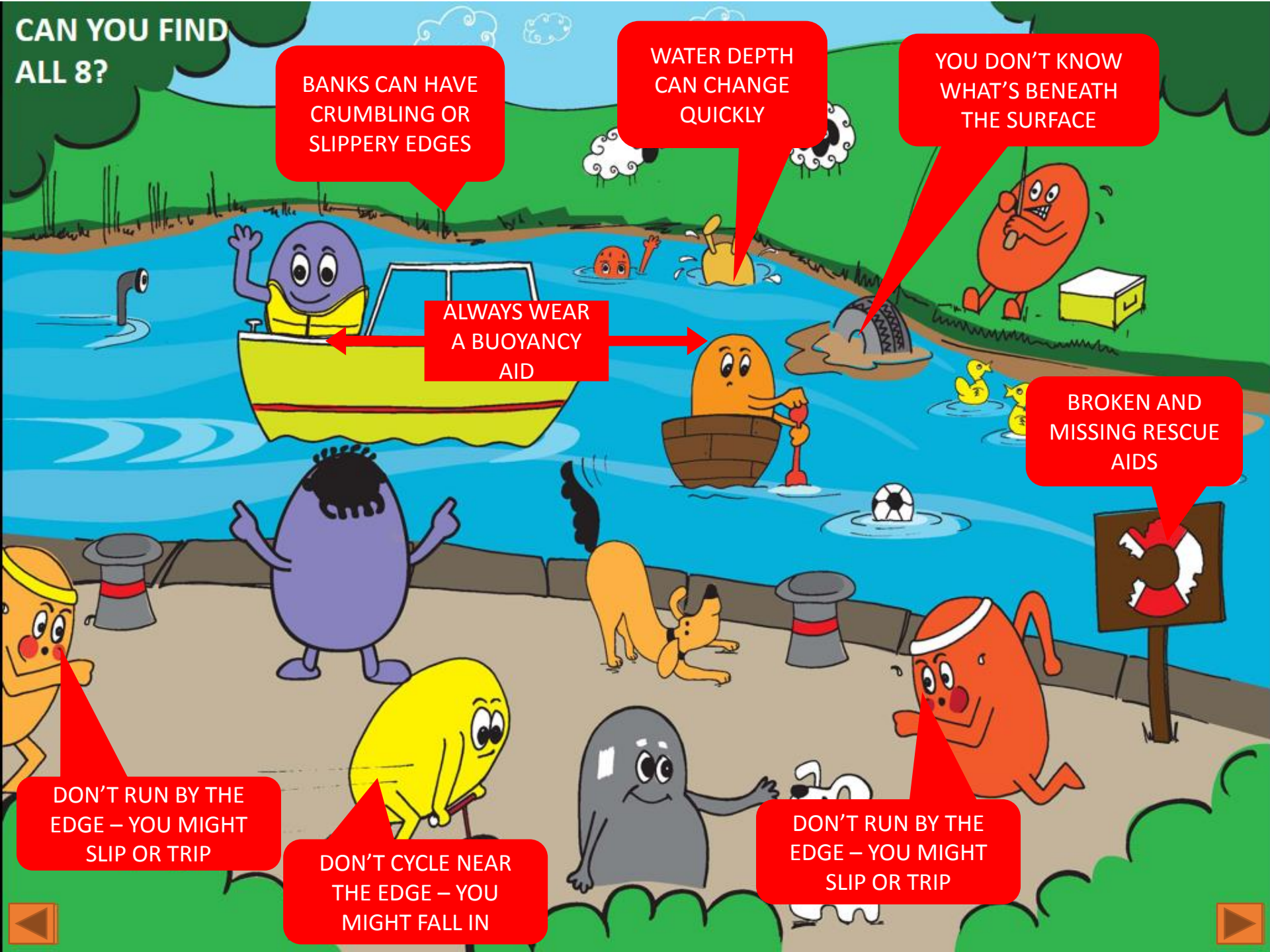
ALWAYS WEAR A BUOYANCY AID

BEWARE SLIPPERY AND CRUMBLING CLIFFS – READ THE SIGNS

DON'T SWIM IN A WATER SPORTS AREA

DON'T JUMP FROM CLIFFS, THE WATER MIGHT BE SHALLOW

AVOID DIRTY AND POLLUTED WATER

BE SUN SAFE – WEAR SUN CREAM

WEAR YOUR BUOYANCY AIDS

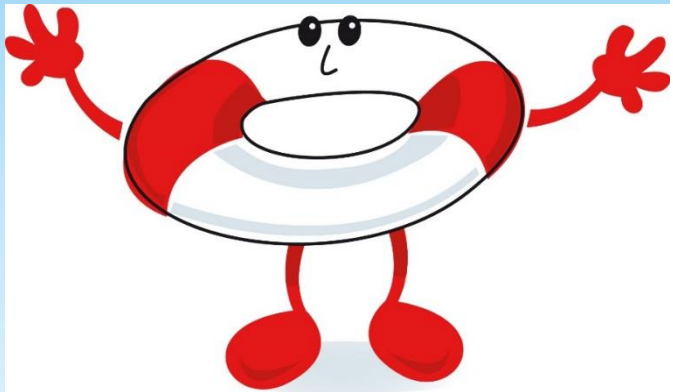
ALWAYS KEEP AN EYE ON CHILDREN

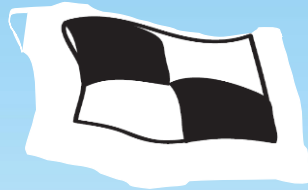

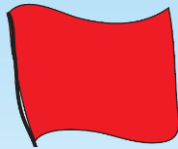
Beach Flags



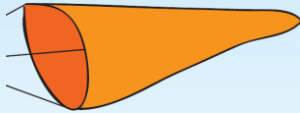
- **Red and Yellow Flags** –Lifeguards patrol here, safest place to swim



- **Black and White Chequered Flags** - Between these flags is for non-swimming water sports such as surfing and wind surfing



- **Red Flags** - Danger, stay out of the water

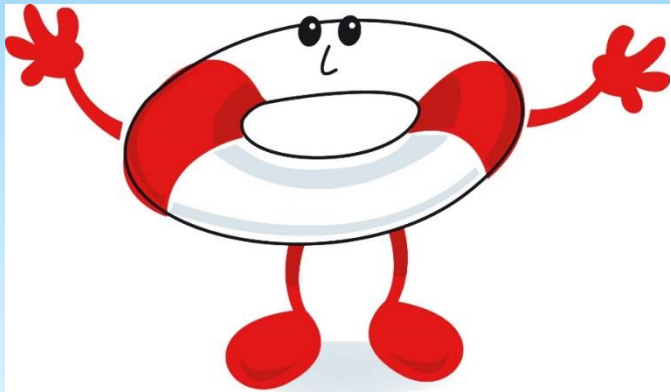


- **Windsock or Orange Flag** - This shows the direction and force of the wind, special care should be taken during an offshore wind

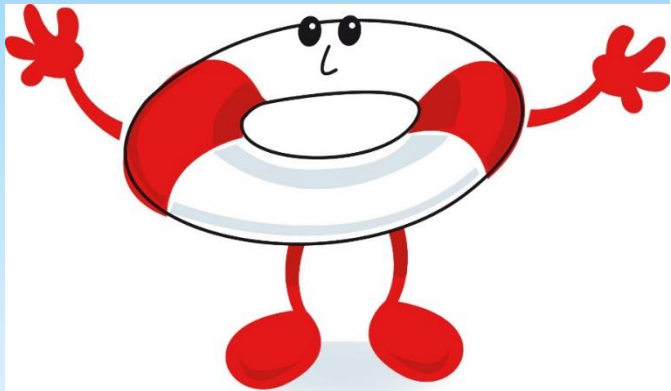

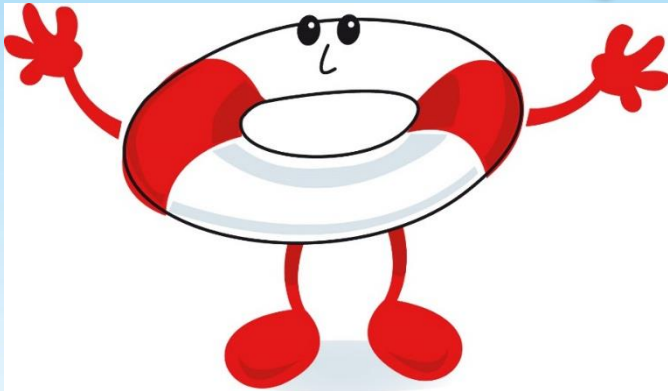
