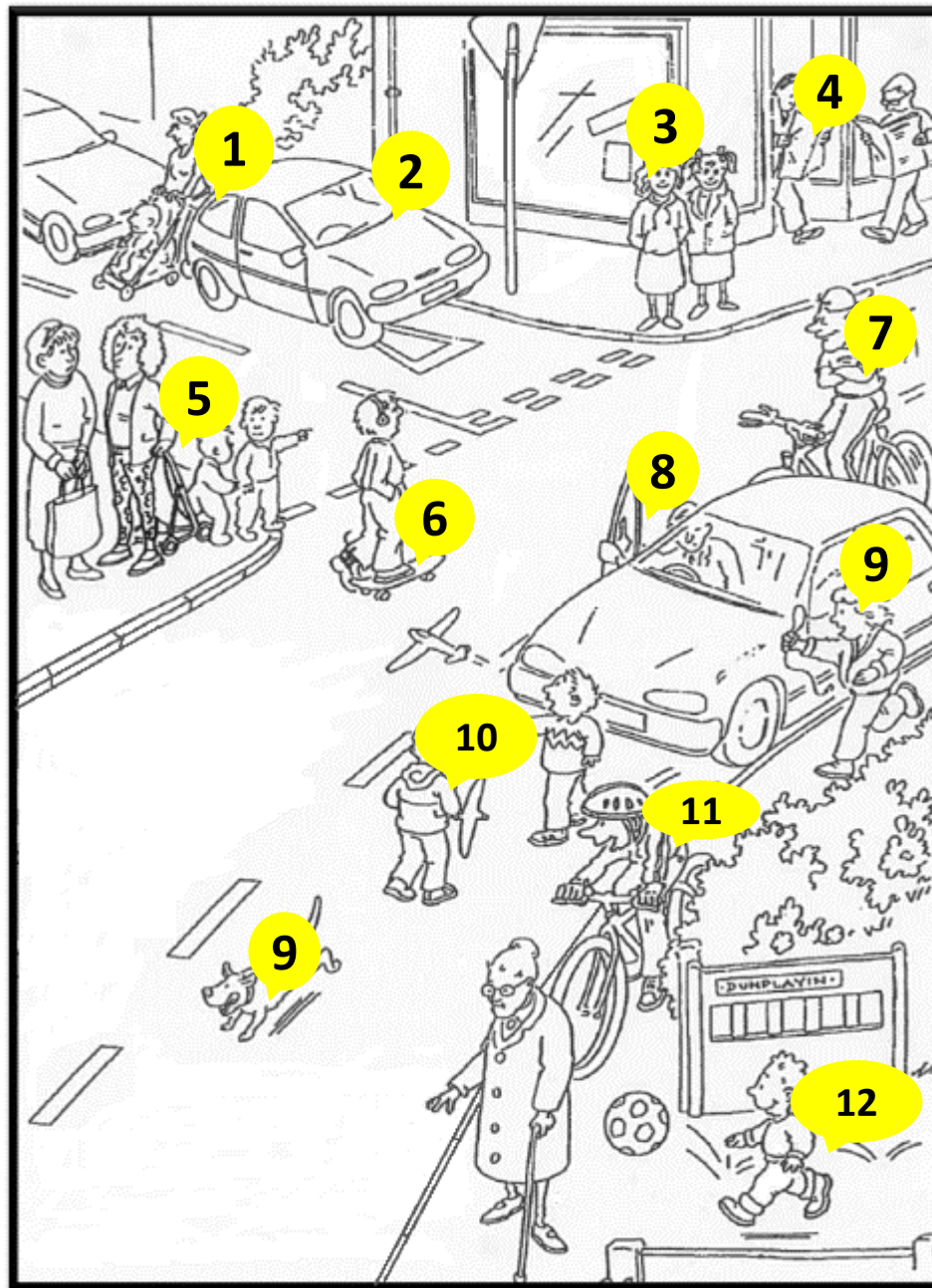
Dangers on the roads



Dangers on the roads



1. Mother pushing buggy into road. Mother crossing between parked cars.
2. Car parked half on the pavement. Car parked close to the junction.
3. Girls standing on the corner for clear view in all directions, but view to the right is blocked by parked cars.
4. Men reading papers and not looking where they are going.
5. Mother talking and not watching children – one stood on edge of kerb. Child not fastened into buggy.
6. Boy using skateboard on the road. Boy wearing headphones. Boy has hands in pockets and loose shoelace.



7. Cyclist is not wearing a helmet or high visibility clothing. No hands on handlebars. Not looking ahead.
8. Driver entering or exiting car without looking. Car parked opposite the junction and on a bend.
9. Boy focussed on chasing his dog which is not on a lead and has run on to the road.
10. Boys playing on the road.
11. Cyclist not looking ahead distracted by dog on road. Cycling on the pavement.
12. Boy running straight out of open gate chasing after ball.
