Bonfire Night Visitors

Members of our PCSO and Tri-responders team in Weardale visited school this week to talk to the children about Bonfire Night and fireworks. They learnt about the firework code and gave some very sensible answers about what people should and shouldn't do to keep safe at this time of year. Their advice is to always visit an organised Bonfire and fireworks display. We hope that everyone stays safe and has a very enjoyable Bonfire Night.

Additional Measures in School

There has been a large increase in the number of children and young people in County Durham testing positive for COVID-19 and the highest case rates are in school age children. This is leading to spread of COVID-19 within families and into older age groups. Therefore it has been recommended to schools across County Durham that they follow recommendations from Durham County Council's Public Health team and have decided to re-introduce measures in addition to those already in place to reduce the risk of COVID-19 transmission in school. Parent Teacher Consultation Appointments

Parent Teacher Consultations will take place from **Monday 15**th **November**. Parents will be sent a text message or email with a link to make their own appointment online via Teachers2Parents, the same system we use for text messages. We had begun to arrange for face to face meetings, however following the recommendations to all Durham schools from the Director of Public Health and Head of Education, we will have to go back to offering a 10 minute phone call with the class teacher to update parents on how their child has settled in, their progress and current targets. We would be grateful if parents help us to stick to our 10 minute time slots and make an additional appointment with the class teacher, via the school office, if there is an issue which requires further discussion.
