That time of year is nearly upon us once again. This year, we are hoping to get back to a little bit of normality. Our Early Years Foundation Stage (Nursery and Reception) will be performing 'Born in Bethlehem' on Wednesday 7th December and Key Stage 1 will be performing 'Santa's Hat' on Thursday 8th December at

10.30am and 5.30pm. Our evening performance for Key Stage 1 is to hopefully allow our working parents an opportunity to see the performance first hand. We would therefore be very grateful if KS1 children return to school at 5pm for the second performance. Tickets for all of these performances cost £1.50 (all proceeds will go to school fund) and a maximum of 4 tickets can be purchased per performance via Parentpay. The deadline for purchasing tickets is **Friday 2nd December**. If you require more tickets, please leave a note on Parentpay when you purchase your tickets and we will let you know if there are any more available following the purchase deadline. Christmas is always a busy time of year and it was always quite stressful trying to have enough hall time for three different performances to practise. We have therefore decided that this year our Key Stage 2 pupils will hold a carol service at St. Mary's and St. Stephen's Church on Thursday 15th December at 2pm instead of a Christmas production. There is no charge for joining us at this service and you will not require a ticket. Key Stage 2 pupils will have the chance to tread the boards when we hold a Key Stage 2 production later in the year.
