How do São Paulo (Brazil) and Durham (UK) differ?

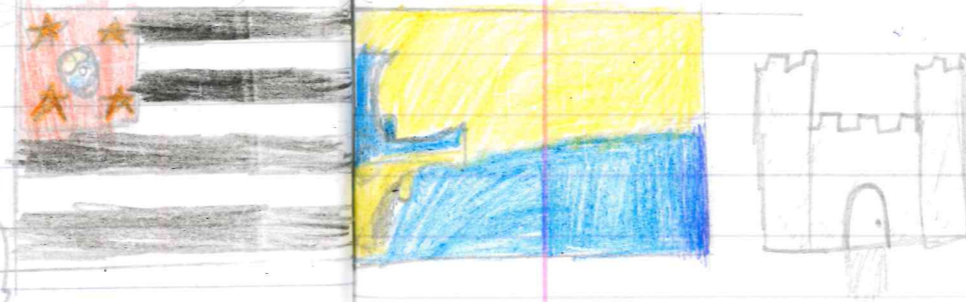
SÃO PAULO

São Paulo was founded in 1554 (1711), January 25th.

Their language they speak is Portuguese.

There are three main landmarks in São Paulo called Paulista Avenue, Neo Química Arena and Allianz Parque.

There is over 12.4 Million people there.



They are in South-East Brazil.

Their event is called Carnival of São Paulo and São Paulo Grand Prix.

Their university is ranked 6th in the country and 78th in the world.

Durham county council has 224 primary schools and 62 secondary schools.

Durham was found in 995 AD.
