Here are some of the activities we will be covering in Nursery this half-term. This overview does not include everything that we will be doing, as many of our topics will be child initiated but hopefully it will give you an insight into some of the learning which will be taking place. Learning will take place inside and outside of Nursery and through community opportunities such as regular visits to the library and shops.

### Physical Development

This half term we will be :

- Practising our pedalling skills outside.
- Perfecting our scissor skills, holding scissors correctly and cutting along lines.
- Practising fine motor skills e.g. threading.

### Communication Language and Literacy

This half term we will be:

- Using newly learned vocabulary in conversations.
- Recalling past events in order.
- Sharing our favourite stories for World Book Day.

### Mathematics

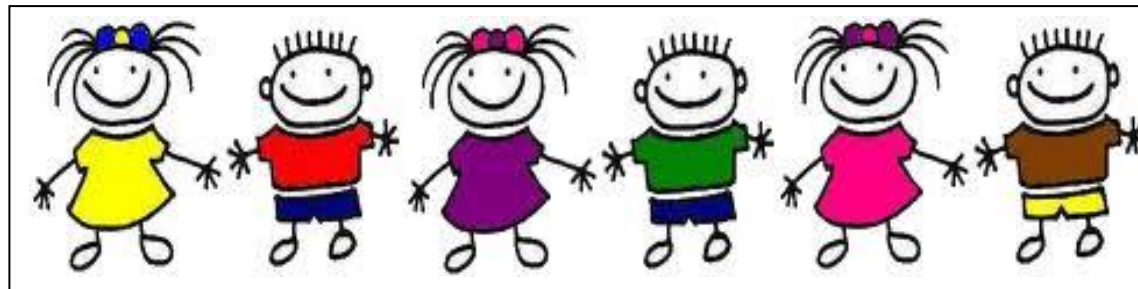
This half term we will be:

- Learning what one more means.
- Noticing 2d shapes in the environment.
- Exploring items which float and sink, discussing why this happens.

### Personal Social and Emotional Development

This half term we will be:

- Thinking carefully about road safety, when out walking.
- Taking turns in conversation, taking into account what people are saying before responding.
- Discussing the importance of personal hygiene.



### Understanding the World

This half term we will be:

- Learning about different types of transport.
- Drawing maps, to log our journeys.
- Talking about Easter and why we celebrate this.

### Expressive Arts and Design

This half term we will be:

- Designing and building our own modes of transport.
- Making crafts for a purpose, handling tools carefully.
- Learning new songs and performing these for an audience.

### Literacy

This half term we will be:

- Learning through books from our reading spine and linking these to journeys.
- Breaking down words into sounds, practising oral blending.
- Noticing letters in our name.
