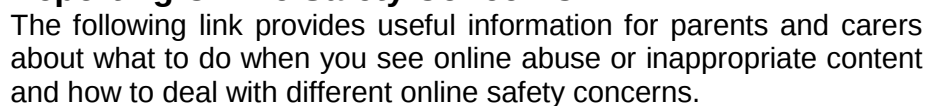
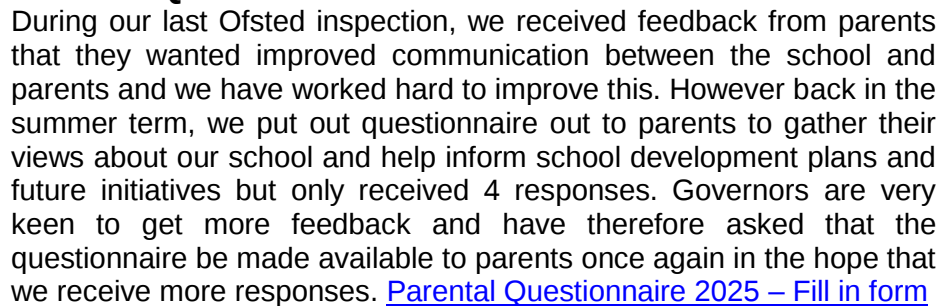


Christmas Performance Tickets
