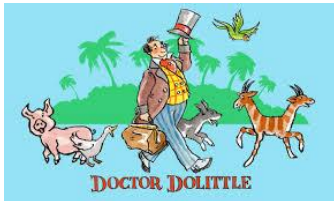


Image musical Theatre - Dr Doolittle
