Rewriting a story in own words. <p>Throughout the term, we will also be focusing on our basic punctuation (Capital letters, full stops, questions marks, exclamation marks. Begin to find 10 more and 10 less than a 2-digit number. • We will also be having a weekly session on Problem solving where the children will be focusing on developing their understanding of number patterns.

We will be preparing for sports day.</p> <p>Outdoor and adventurous –This term we will also be attending forest school. <i>*Note: children should make sure their PE kits are in school every day as we may take advantage of the drier days for PE across Summer term.</i></p>
